Vermont Uniform Medical Prior Authorization Form Update

MVP Health Care® (MVP) is committed to sharing statutory updates and other requirements by the Department of Financial Regulation (DFR). This notification is to inform Vermont Providers that in compliance with changes under 18 V.S.A Section 9418(b), MVP is adopting the uniform prior authorization form that has been approved by DFR for requests for prescription drugs, medical procedures (including behavioral health conditions), and medical supplies. An electronic version of the *Vermont Uniform Medical Prior Authorization* form will be available for use on the MVP website beginning January 1, 2024.

The new form will be found by visiting mvphealthcare.com/providers, and selecting *Resources*, then *Forms*, then *Admissions and Prior Authorizations*, then selecting the *Vermont Uniform Medical Prior Authorization* form.
