

## MVP is participating with CAQH to utilize their Provider Data Portal

MVP Health Care® (MVP) values the care you provide in support of our Members and remains dedicated to improving how you work with us.

Effective July 1, 2025, MVP will begin a phased approach between July and August 2025 to partner with CAQH to enable credentialed Providers<sup>[1]</sup> to review and attest to the accuracy of their demographic information <sup>[2]</sup> within the CAQH Provider Data Portal. CAQH's web-based Provider Data Portal enables Providers to enter their professional and practice information once and submit it to multiple health plans, reducing administrative burden.

By participating with CAQH, MVP will ensure that Members have access to current Provider information and comply with state and federal regulations requiring Participating Providers to review and attest to the accuracy of their information published in the Provider Directory every 90 days.

## **Provider Next Steps**

- You will receive an automated email from CAQH when MVP requests your information during MVP's phased go-live this summer. When you receive the email from CAQH, please follow the instructions. MVP will also email Providers to give additional advance notice of when they will be included in our phased CAQH go-live
- **If you have a CAQH account,** you do not need to do anything at this time. Please look out for subsequent emails from CAQH and MVP and follow the instructions
- If you do not have a CAQH account, please register for the CAQH Provider Data Portal at proview.caqh.org/PR/Registration. Please look out for subsequent emails from CAQH and MVP and follow the instructions
