MVP Health Care® (MVP) is pleased to announce our collaboration with Availity®, a leading health information network offering a centralized platform known as Availity Essentials™.

Availity Essentials is a secure, web-based portal that links health care Providers with health plans through a unified, multi-payer system. It helps simplify administrative and clinical processes, minimizes manual work, and boosts the efficiency and accuracy of communication within the health care industry.

Starting July 20, 2026, Providers who see MVP Members can perform several activities electronically, including:

- Claims Submission
- Claim Status Inquiry
- Eligibility and Benefits Inquiry
- Member Search to easily find MVP Members
- Electronic Prior Authorization for prescriptions, genetic testing, and oncology services via tools in the *MVP Payer Space* in Availity

How to Get Started: Designate an Administrator for Your Organization

If your practice doesn't have an Availity account, the first step is to designate an Availity Essentials administrator for your organization. Your administrator is the person responsible for registering your organization with Availity Essentials and managing user accounts. This person should have legal authority to sign agreements on behalf of your organization.
